Solve Problems Peacefully		Can identify different perspectives on issues and appreciate them; generates, evaluates and uses strategies to solve problems. Can compromise to meet the needs of others.	
Value Diversity		Can recognize and value differences in others; identifies when something is unfair and advocates for others; identifies the value in diversity; takes action to promote diversity and human rights.	
Build Relationships		Can develop and maintain positive relationships with family, at school, at work, and in community; can establish relationships with people in different age, gender, and cultural groups.
