- Students who are selected for Honours 9 Courses (English, Math, and/or Science), will be placed in the correct classes after offers have been accepted.
- English Language Learners will be placed in academic courses that best meet their level of language acquisition (based on an oral and written language assessment).
- Placement in the following courses is based on consultation with school team and parents/guardians: Math 9 Adapted, Math 9 Support, Learning Centre.
