

Provincial Assessments

Numeracy 10, Literacy 10 & Literacy 12, and French Immersion 12 Provincial Assessment for Semester 1 will be written over three days.

- a. Tuesday, January 26 – **Literacy 10** and **French Immersion 12**
- b. Wednesday, January 27 – **Numeracy 10**
- c. Thursday, January 28 – **Literacy 12**

Students enrolled in English 10, Math 10, English 12, and Francais Langue Seconde-Immersion 12 in Semester 1 will be scheduled to write these assessments. Grade 11 and 12 students who have missed writing these assessments will also be scheduled as these assessments are required for graduation. Parents and students will receive emails closer to the date of the assessment which will indicate the location and time of their assessment. Lists will also be posted in the counselling office for students to check and confirm when, where, and what time they are writing.

Students taking the above courses in Semester 2 will be scheduled to write the assessments in April and/or June depending on the assessment that needs to be completed.


