
#### Body Science Workshops with Cath Blythe for Kids on Monday and Tuesday

Rochester students will participate in one of the body science sessions on either Monday or Tuesday. Sessions for grade 3's and for grade 4/5's will occur during the school day. Sessions for children in Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Grade 2 occur after school starting at 3:10pm; children in Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 must be accompanied by an adult as per SD 43 protocol.

Children attend ONLY ONE SESSION. For those K-2 children and their parents, you can choose either the Monday or Tuesday Session.
