Our Grant Writing Committee lead by Dept. Head Taryn Harms is responsible for gaining almost \$10,000 in various sports equipment and green grants this year. We are now working with SD43 on a three stage plan to remedy the shade issues and aesthetics of our outside playground and school entry areas.

A big part of our grant earnings will be allocated to planting shade trees around the new playground site. Planting is expected to occur in the fall. As well, the eye sore known as "sad slope" will be addressed. This is the dirt hill that slopes from our gym towards the basketball court. We are in need of someone in the architectural landscape field to help us with planning and designing the slope. If you know anyone out there, please let us know!

This week, the heat and light issues in the windowed hallway in our upper balcony area were addressed with the installation of new solar window film. The reduction in heat and brightness is noticeable. I also learned this week that our much anticipated exterior window roll down blinds are due for installation over the summer. This will add much to the security and look of the school.
