## Special Guest

- Amanda Panahi spoke on SOGI (sexual orientation and gender identity) education and shared a video on it. She displayed SOGI books from Maillard.
- SOGI is mandated in our curriculum. It is infused into the curriculum in different ways; in elementary, it is primarily by picture books and conversations.
- The school library doesn't have very many SOGI books. We want kids to be able to pull a book off the shelf where they can see themselves.
- Many books are available in both English and French.
- Questions: how much would it cost to stock the library? Can French books be stocked from the French fund? Approximately $\$ 500$ for English books. French books can be bought with the French fund.


## Principal's message

- Update on RAC week (Real acts of caring). Teachers put hearts on classrooms, kids are sending messages of kindness to each other. There was a pancake breakfast which was a huge success.
- Jump rope for Heart was on Monday. There's still a week or two to donate. Over \$700 raised so far.

## Treasurer's report
