

# Scott Creek PAC Meeting Minutes -

### Welcome and Introductions

- 1. Approval of meeting agenda 1<sup>st</sup> Ali, 2<sup>nd</sup> Katie; all in favor -> approved
- Approval of Minutes from previous PAC meeting (June 17, 2020) 1<sup>st</sup> Katie, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ali; all in favor -> approved
- 3. Executive positions need to be filled for the 2020/2021 school year

-Alumni executive members of the PAC spoke about the role of the PAC as that of an advisory liaison and being a supporter rather than that of a fundraising catapult

-All executive positions require minimal time commitment

-Positions that are required to be filled are:

President, treasurer, and DPAC representative

-Lisa Rinke will send out a message to the school community asking for parent self-identification for possible executive roles

## 4. <u>President's report</u>: Katie Tong reporting

-Commitments include attending to 4 yearly PAC meetings, setting an agenda for the meetings and liaising with student leadership students -In the past a Donation letter was sent out to the parent community asking for school donations to support school events/ special guest speakers, t-shirts, bus costs, staff luncheon however this letter will not be distributed this year, as requested by Lisa and Colleen

### 5. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Ali reporting

-Current balances: Gaming account \$7926.00

General account \$1450.00

Total amount: approx. \$8253.00

-PAC Funds to support purchase of community t-shirts have already been voted on and passed for this school year

-Ali confirmed that \$7,200.00 was pre-approved for t-shirt purchase last year -Since casinos are currently closed (due to Covid) there is uncertainty as to whether Scott Creek will be receiving the Gaming grant

-Last year's grant was \$13,200 which amounted to \$20/student

-Ali has kindly already submitted the application for the Gaming grant and has also completed the paperwork for the fiscal year

<u>DPAC</u> – Paymaneh is not present and not returning as an active member, **no** report at this time

-Commitment is attendance of one monthly DPAC meeting a month and subsequent report out to the school PAC

### 6. <u>Administrators Report</u> – Lisa Rinke and Colleen Castonguay reporting

-Our Scott Creek community is composed of 660 students in 26 divisions -Enrollment has dropped as approx. 25 students have moved to different programs

-The focus for this year's start-up is Health and Safety first

-Students are currently staying in their learning groups

-Students do not have platooning of teachers and all subjects are taught by their core teacher

-Expo's has shifted and Expo teachers move from class to class

-This year each student will have 3 different explorations

-School goal for this year is focusing on Wellness through the entrie middle school community

New mural designed by Dean Lowes is a positive representation of our community

-All students will participate in a school wide read *The Benefits of Being an Octopus* 

-Lanyards (connected to Team by color) and school masks were distributed to all students

-Currently less than 10% of students are in gradual transition option of learning -Lisa will be sending out a photo of the mural to the parent community
