

Scott Creek Appropriate Dress Policy

Students should be able to move freely without embarrassment to themselves or to others in the building. This requires that:

- Shorts, tops, skirts, etc. be long enough so that movement can occur without exposing one's body or undergarments
 - As a general rule shorts / skirts should extend beyond the students fingertips when extended down their leg and shirt necklines should be high enough to cover a student's cleavage.
- Shirts and tops must be long enough to cover the midriff
- Spaghetti strap tops are not appropriate; shirt and top straps must have a wide shoulder seam
- All underwear, including bra straps must be covered at all times
- Clothing with slogans and pictures inappropriate for middle school is not to be worn
- Students should wear solid footwear that is attached to their feet and provides adequate traction if they were to go out to the field in an evacuation, and adequate protection if an item was dropped on their feet (No open toes).
