Update

Emergency Preparedness and Student Release: Wednesday, May 4th, 1:30pm

For school communities, taking care of student safety is a fundamental concern and responsibility. While we engage in ongoing safety drills and education at our school site, we less frequently undergo school-wide safety procedures that involve our whole community. Emergency Preparedness Week is May 2nd through 6th and School District #43 is conducting a district-wide gradual student release procedure at all school sites over the course of this week. It is important for us to revisit and practice our gradual release procedures to ensure they are soundly in place to protect the well-being of our students in the event of a major earthquake or natural disaster.

Seaview's **Gradual Student Release Day** will take place on Wednesday, May 4th at 1:30pm. **Parents or their designate will need to come to the school and pick up their children.** Our release procedure will take place from our back field and children will only be released to parents or designates who produce identification to school staff. We will be practicing a procedure identical to what is in place in the event of a true episode. **Please be aware that our front parking lot will be blocked off as this area, in the event of a disaster, would be reserved for emergency vehicles. You will need to park on the street and walk onto site or walk to the school from home.** It is important that our drill is authentic.

Procedure

1. Students will be released to parents or emergency contacts listed on the Emergency Release Form only.
2. Parents or contacts must produce and show ID even if known to school.
3. The front lot will be closed off to **ALL** traffic. Absolutely no vehicles are allowed access.

4. Students will be gathered in drill formation on the back field. Parents must not cross the field to student area.
5. Parents will line up at the sign-out stations in the undercover area, show ID and runners will collect children. Sign-out stations will be alpha by last name with a separate area for contacts picking up multiple children.

This exercise is a learning activity: we hope to gain experience that will inform our policies and procedures moving forward. Thank you very much in advance for your support.

****NOTE:** Children in after school programs must be collected as per the above procedure. Programs, however, will commence at 3:00pm. For the purposes of authenticity, we need to ensure all families participate in the release.


