# **E Forms Now Available on the Website**

At the beginning of each school year, there are number of necessary forms that we need you to complete. **These forms are now available on the website.** It is crucial that you complete the required forms for each student. They will be available online in our Seaview Community Portal www.sd43.bc.ca/elementary/Seaview

- 1. School Policies
- 2. **Emergency Release**

Additionally, you will find on that page the following optional forms:

- **Medical Alert** To be completed at the start of each school year but only if your child has a medical concern.
- **Volunteer Application** To be completed once at each school level by parents and non-parents who are planning to volunteer at our school. Note: you also need to drop off a criminal record check (CRC) at the school office. Contact the school to ensure your CRC is still valid.
- **Driver Application** To be completed at the start of each school year by volunteers who are planning
  - to transport students during school field trips. Note: you will also need to drop off a driver's abstract and a criminal record check at the school office and complete a Volunteer Application form (once per school level).
- Absence Report (available currently) To be completed when your child is going to be away from school

#### **Parking Lot Safety**

As a community we are collectively concerned at all times with the safety and well-being of our children. To that end, please regard carefully the signage in our parking lot and comply with the instructions. Whenever possible, avoid driving in our parking lot. You can use street parking and walk on, walk or ride from home, carpool or avoid the busier times. Thank in you in advance for your support and courtesy toward others in our parking lot. Please do not leave your car unattended in no parking areas. This is very problematic and a safety issue for emergency vehicles and access.

#### Visits to the School

During the school day if you have a need to contact your child, please stop by or call the office so we can help.

Visitors to the school who are here to volunteer need to sign in at the office and wear a visitor's pass. This practice

is to assist children in knowing how to spot safe adults in our building and also protects the safety and privacy of our students during school time. Thank you in advance for helping us in maintaining a safe and orderly environment.

To honour Terry Fox and raise funds for the Terry Fox Foundation, Seaview is holding our annual donation drive and school run.
