This unique opportunity is part of a wonderful community partnership between Simon Fraser University and School District 43. During the four days of our "School of Wonderstanding," students will participate in a number of different activities such as arts and crafts, indoor/outdoor games, sports, science experiments, drama and of course- **FUN**. All sessions are fully supervised by Student Teachers in the Professional Development Program, as part of their teacher training and they will be working under the supervision of certified teachers. Each session is designed to excite and delight participants with hands-on, creative learning opportunities to strengthen the connection of "wonder" and "understanding" of the world around us.
