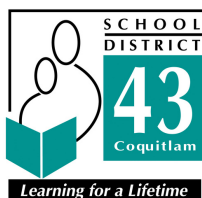

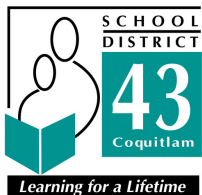
ASPIRE MARTIAL ARTS

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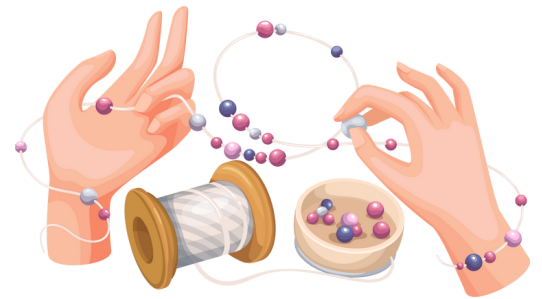


TRACK STARS CITY OF PORT MOODY

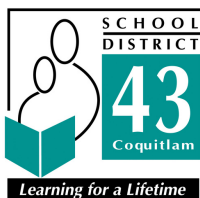


WORLD OF BEADWORK

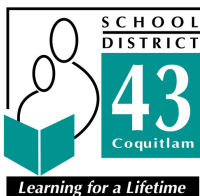
STELLAR PLAY – ARCHERY & PLAY

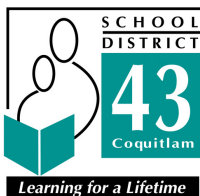
