### \*Student Laptops/iPADS/Tablets/Netbooks

Students at Summit Middle have access to the district-wide network through wireless access at the school. Personal laptops and netbooks can be registered at the school and students use district usernames and passwords to connect to the Wi-Fi. If you are interested in having your child use this resource, please discuss with your child the appropriate level of care and responsibility you expect them to maintain with personal equipment brought to school.

If you are considering purchasing a new electronic device for your child over the summer, netbooks or chromebooks (small portable laptops) are light and compact and very well suited for email and Internet research as well as for word processing. Less expensive than a full size laptop, they can be an effective tool for student learning. Once your child is assigned a home room/core teacher, you will be required to fill out a Privately Owned Personal Devices (POPD) form online at our school website, Parent eForms.
