

Terry Fox Senior Sail – Grads of 2020

When is it?

Tuesday, September 24th, 2019

What do I get for \$50?

Bus transportation to and from downtown Vancouver (Foot of Denman St) docks, 3-hour cruise on the Queen of Diamonds, DJ and dancing, and a great time with all your friends. Pop, sandwiches, munchies and desserts are supplied on board, but we still recommend you have something to eat beforehand as well.

Can I buy tickets the day of the event?

NO! All tickets must be purchased prior to Tuesday, September 24th. **YOU CANNOT BUY A TICKET UNLESS YOU HAVE PAID YOUR STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES (\$45).**

Where do I go on the 24th?

All students and teachers will meet outside **the school main entry at 3:45 pm** for check-in. **BRING ID.**

How do I get to the dock?

ALL STUDENTS will be riding in rented buses. Students are **not permitted** to find their own ride to the event. Students will board the buses at 4:10 pm. The buses will leave the school at 4:00 pm and arrive at the docks 5:30 pm.

Can I bring a guest from another school or another grade?

NO. This is an event for the Terry Fox 2020 Grads only.

How long is the cruise?

We arrive at the dock at 5:30 pm and all students must go through the boat security before boarding. Once on board we will sail from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

How do I get back to Terry Fox?

The buses will be leaving the dock shortly after 9:00 pm and arriving back at Terry Fox at approx. 10:00-10:15 pm.

What should I wear?

The dress code is semi-formal. This doesn't mean ball gowns and tuxedos. This means dresses, skirts, pants and dress shirts. No jeans. To fully enjoy the evening, bring a jacket (it will be cool on the top deck) and footwear to walk on the deck. **No backpacks or bags will be permitted.** Small purses are allowed, but you are responsible for all your own belongings.

Students who do not abide by the school rules and the School District Student Code of Conduct will be sent home at his/her parents' expense. No refunds for the cost of the event will be provided should a student breach any school rules as outlined above. Please be aware students who are not able to abide by all school rules and the School District Student Code of Conduct will not be permitted to participate in future grad-related events.
