When will you work?

Team members must be available to work during Playland operating hours, normally from 10am to 7pm; however some days the park will close at midnight (including every day of the Fair). Team members must be able to work weekend and evening shifts.

Fair August 18th to September 3rd: 4-5 shifts per week/*weekends required*

September: 1-2 shifts per week (on weekends)

October: 2-3 evening shifts per week (during Fright Nights)
