# University of Victoria Entrance Scholarships

1. Entrance scholarships based on **admission** average unless otherwise specified in the terms of reference of scholarship

- Minimum of 90% admission average
  - No application required
  - Majority of them non- renewable

- 2. Specific Criteria Application Awards
- Entrance scholarships based on admission average and other criteria- application required, apply online
- Renewable & non renewable scholarships available

# Western University National Scholarship program- nomination required

\*Grade 12 students if you would like to be considered for a nomination, please hand in a bragsheet and a short paragraph on how you meet the criteria to Ms. Tsang by 3:30pm on January 14, 2022\*

Each school can nominate up to 4 students, (note: a school can nominate 1 additional student (in addition to the 4) if that student is an international (visa) student).

- Minimum 90% overall academic average on all Grade 12 courses
- Outstanding academic performance, creative & innovative thought, passion for pursuit of learning, exceptional achievement in extracurricular activities, community service (contributions to school and community)

# Cmolik Scholarship- nomination required

\*Grade 12 students if you would like to be considered for a nomination, please hand in a brag sheet and a short paragraph on how you meet the criteria to Ms. Tsang by 3:30pm on January 14, 2022\* Applications deadline February 7, 2022

- Be a current resident of BC
- Have lived in Canada for at least 7 years,
- Be in Grade 12 or a recent secondary school graduate,
- Have demonstrated financial need,
- Have faced adversity,
- Plan to be a full-time student,
- Be ineligible for the BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care),
- Use funding for a post-secondary institution, trade or college, and
- Be endorsed by their school principal.
- (demonstrate tenacity, focus, and ability required to succeed with individual post-secondary goal)

**All applicants must be endorsed by their secondary school. The principal's nomination letter must be included with the application.**

## **STUDENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Graduate high school or Cégep in the 2021/2022 academic year

Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident

Plan to enroll in an eligible STEM program at one of our partner universities (\$100,000 or \$80,000)

Meet the following criteria:

1. Academic excellence, AND
2. Leadership, charisma and creativity

**Strong consideration will be given to students with financial need**

Be entrepreneurial- minded and intend to pursue a career in one or more of the following areas: Technology, Engineering, Entrepreneurship & business enterprise, Applied scientific research

Will NOT consider students who

1. Focus on activism (environmental/political/societal)

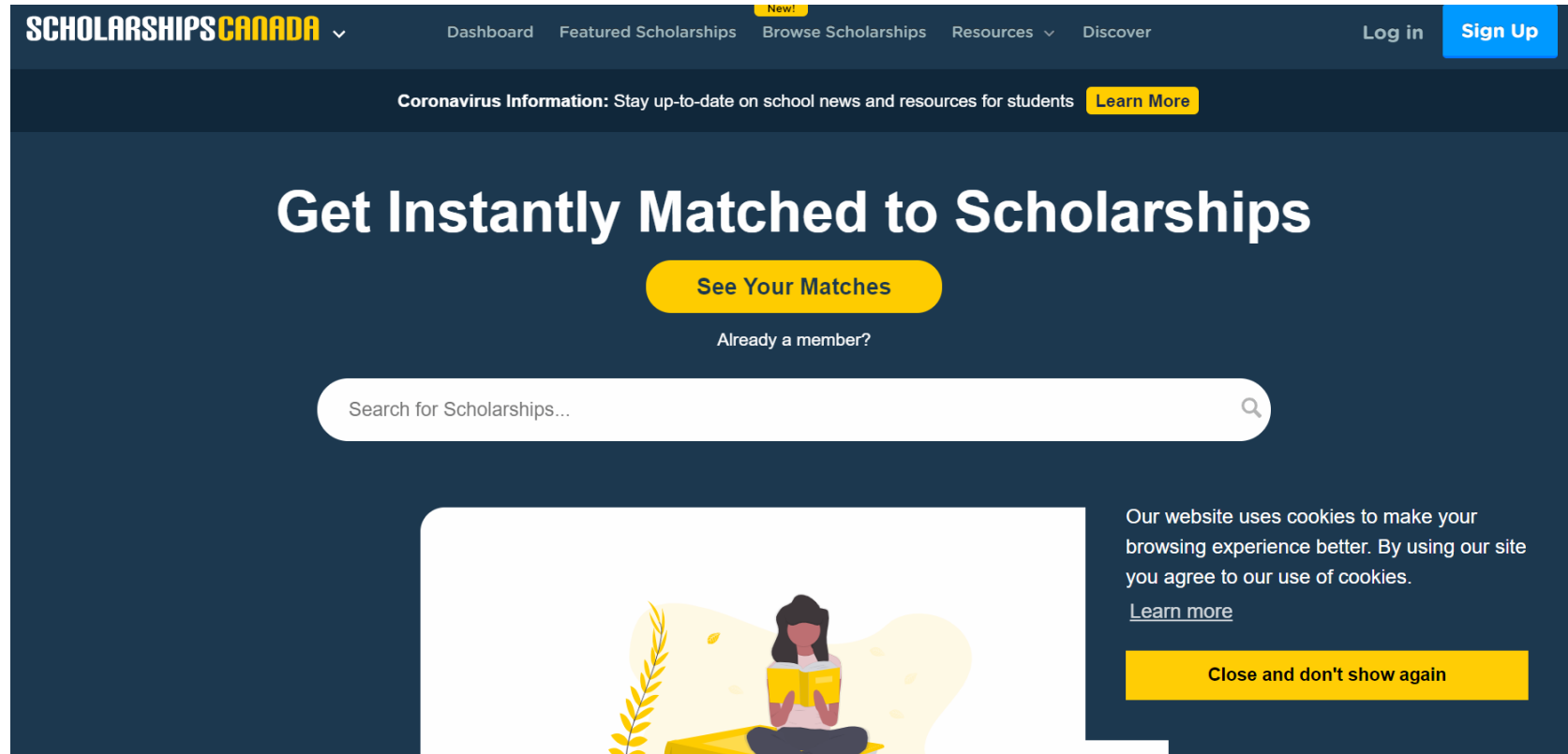
