Bursaries will be awarded to qualified applicants through the Legion Poppy Fund and are available to the children or grand children of Veterans and ex-service personnel.

Students without a Legion or Military affiliation are also eligible to apply for Bursaries that are available through the Organization's Educational Fund.

Awards are based on financial need and good grades; an applicant's total family income cannot exceed \$ 90,000 annually. This information is confidential and completed at the Branch Interview.

How to find proof of Military Service will be supplied with applications directed to the Poppy Fund. This will help students "shake the family tree" so to speak.
