 - No application required
 - Majority of them non- renewable

- Renewable & non renewable scholarships available

Douglas College Entrance Scholarships/Awards- Deadline March 31,2023

These scholarships and awards recognize students who excel in their studies and contribute to their communities, including the promotion of social justice and Indigenous Truth and Reconciliation within their schools and/or communities.

Entrance Scholarships: Students must have a minimum admission GPA of 3.5 and significant contributions to their school or community.

Entrance Awards: Students must have a minimum admission GPA of 3.0 and significant contributions to their school or community.

-All round excellence, outstanding academic performance, ability for creative & innovative thought and passion for the pursuit of learning, extracurricular activities such as arts & athletics, commitment to community service (ongoing contributions to school & community life)

Each school is able to nominate up to 4 students for the National Scholarship Program (note: a school can nominate 1 additional student (in addition to the 4) if that student is an international (visa) student).

Cmolik Scholarship- nomination required

Grade 12 students if you would like to be considered for a nomination, please hand in a bragsheet and a short paragraph on how you meet the criteria to Ms. Tsang by 3:30pm on January 10, 2023 Applications deadline February 7, 2023

- Be a current resident of BC
- Have lived in Canada for at least 7 years,
- Be in Grade 12 or a recent secondary school graduate,
- Have demonstrated financial need,
- Have faced adversity,
- Plan to be a full-time student,
- Be ineligible for the BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care),
- Use funding for a post-secondary institution, or college, and
- Be endorsed by their school principal.
- Scholarship recipients have faced adversity but have responded with positivity and tenacity, achieving academic and social goals.

All applicants must be endorsed by their secondary school. The principal's nomination letter must be included with the application.

2. Leadership, charisma and creativity

Strong consideration will be given to students with financial need

Be entrepreneurial- minded and intend to pursue a career in one or more of the following areas: Technology, Engineering, Entrepreneurship & business enterprise, Applied scientific research

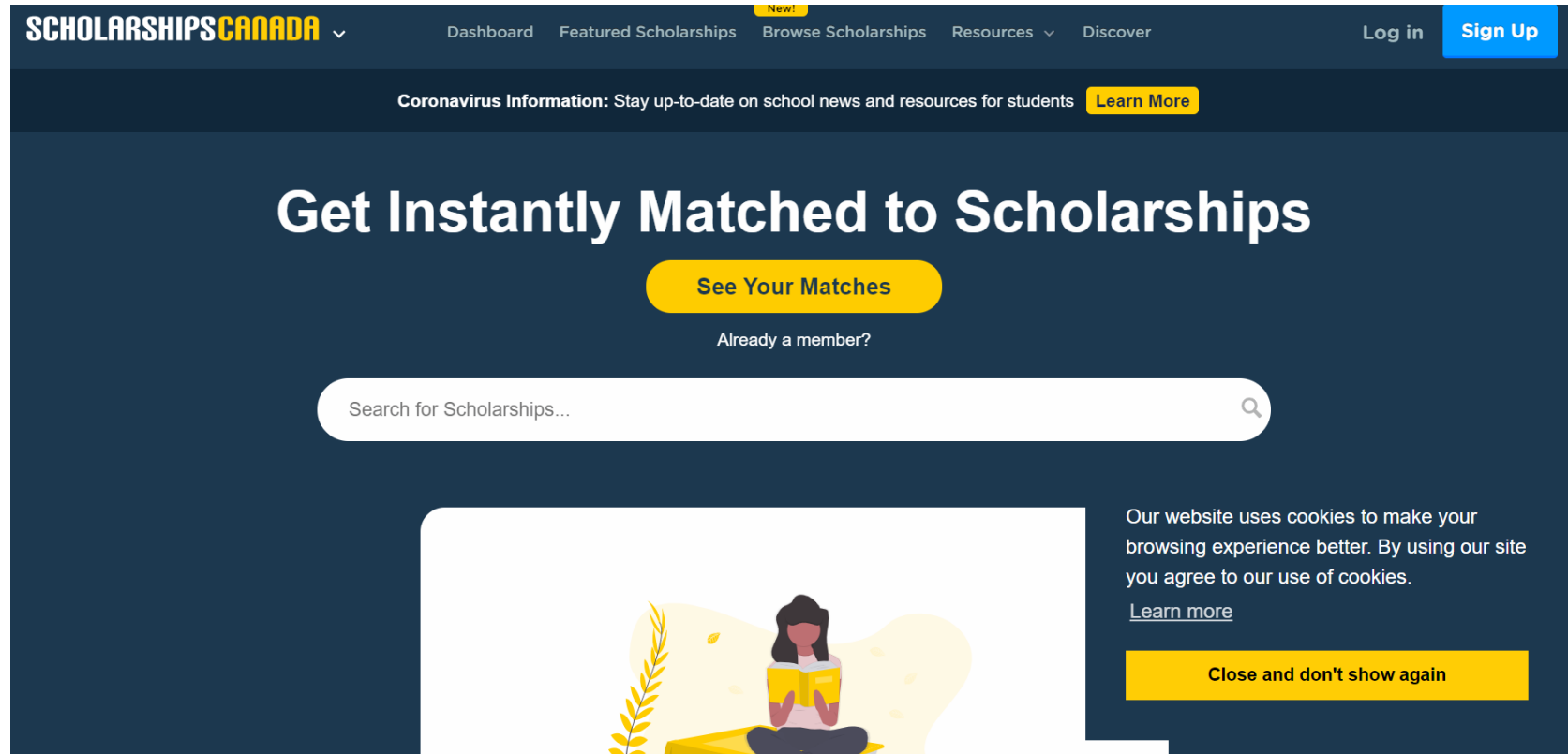
Beedie Luminaries -due January 12, 2023 at 9am
