Selection Criteria

Identifying young women with the potential to lead for a lifetime means getting to know students beyond their academic achievements. The selection process for the Alpha Gamma Delta UBC Entrance Award seeks those who share our values:

- the pursuit of wisdom
- developing and prizing health and vigour of body
- contributing to the world's work in the communities where we are placed
- holding truth inviolable, sincerity essential, kindness invaluable
- possessing high ideals and working to attain them

Conditions of Eligibility

Applicants must:

- identify as a woman
- have applied to UBC – Vancouver with the intent to enter their first year of study in September 2026

While we hope applicants will consider joining a sorority at UBC, neither participation in recruitment nor membership in any sorority is a requirement of this award. No applicant, including the recipient, will be given any preference in membership selection during [UBC Sororities Recruitment](#).

Selection Process

The application deadline is 11:59pm Pacific Time on March 31, 2026. Along with the online form, applicants must submit a reference letter, evidence of their UBC application (and acceptance, if applicable), current (unofficial) transcript, and a 1-page resume/CV of their high school activities.

Shortlisted candidates may be invited to a second round reception-style interview with UBC alumnae in April, held in Vancouver, Calgary and Toronto. Second round invitees unable to attend in person will be given the opportunity for an online interview.

The Alpha Gamma Delta UBC Entrance Award is managed by the [Vancouver Foundation](#). The award winner will be announced once the selected finalist has confirmed her acceptance of UBC's offer of admission. The award will be paid by the Vancouver Foundation directly to UBC to be applied towards the recipient's student account.

About Alpha Gamma Delta and UBC Sororities

Alpha Gamma Delta was founded in 1904 at Syracuse University, New York, and established the Delta Zeta chapter at UBC in 1930. The Alpha Gamma Delta UBC Entrance Award was established to honour our chapter's 95th anniversary at UBC in 2025.

Our alumnae chapter consists of over 1,200 UBC alumnae living all over the world, and nearly 200 Alpha Gams from other universities who live in BC. Our mission is to connect, empower and celebrate our members, to "inspire the woman, impact the world". We host regular events for members of all ages and support philanthropic efforts to address hunger and food insecurity in our communities.

As alumnae, we support our chapter at UBC through scholarships, leadership awards, and a student exchange bursary. We host career nights featuring prominent alumnae from different fields of interest and create one-on-one connections between alumnae and students.
