District Scholarships Application Form for School District 43 (Coquitlam) Students (2026)

Important: Applications close on **April 15, 2026** (EOD). To apply for scholarships offered through the School District, you must:

- Be a student graduating in the current school year.
- Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (International and Refugee Students are not eligible).
- Attend a school in School District 43 (Coquitlam).

Application Requirements:

1. **Personal Letter** (approximately 300 words): Describe how receiving a scholarship will assist you in achieving your post-secondary goals, any adversity you've overcome, your proudest achievements, or any special circumstances the committee should be aware of (e.g., financial need, unique learning needs, service to others).
2. **Resume:** Prepare a personal resume to upload with your application. Your resume should include information such as grade 11 and 12 courses, community and/or school based extracurricular activities, employment, leadership, and volunteerism. (Ensure to include information that may be relevant to scholarships for which you are applying)

The personal information you submit will be used to verify your eligibility for scholarships. This form must be submitted by the student applicant for consideration. Third party applicants will be denied.
