
## British Columbia Graduation Requirements

#### Gredits must be earned in the following subject areas or courses:

- Language Arts 10 (4 credits)
- Language Arts 11 (4 credits)
- Language Arts 12 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 10 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- Mathematics 10 (4 credits)
- Mathematics 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- Science 10 (4 credits)
- Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)

- Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits)
- An Arts Education and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits)
- Career Life Education (4 credits)
- Career Life Connections (4 credits)
- 28 elective credits (28 credits)
- Numeracy & Literacy Exams
- Indigenous Credit (EFP 11 or BC First Peoples 12)





- Designed for high school students who have, or are seeking, full or part time paid employment in one of the 100+ apprentice able trades (see ITABC.ca)
- Earn up to 16 credits (4 courses) towards graduation for employment
- Work hours count towards the completion of Level One training (1,500 hrs.)
- Qualify for a \$1,000 scholarship if you continue to work in the field 6 months after graduation (December) or you amass 900 hours




# Post- Secondary Options

# Getting ready to apply to awards, bursaries, scholarships

- 1. Be sure you have a social insurance number
- Know your personal education number (PEN), required for post-secondary school applications
- 3. Think about who can act as your reference, e.g., teacher, counsellor, coach, supervisor at work
- 4. 3 scholarship meetings during the school year, generally: October, November, March


