Why does education change?

We are aiming for all children to arrive at school by the first bell at 8:50am.



# **Our Social Emotional Learning Goal**

#### Our Goal:

To improve student learning through social emotional learning, self-regulation and problem solving skills.

#### **Community Engagement:**

Parents were invited to complete the Social Emotional Learning Index in April 2016. The results were used to compare to the teacher completed results in May 2016. 276 responses were recorded, which is approximately half the school population.

Social Emotional Learning is often featured in school newsletters and PAC Meetings. In the May PAC Meetings, parents were provided with a brief inservice on the Mood Meter.

Parents were invited to our Learning Celebration on April 27 & 28 that highlighted the work the children did with their Class Charters.

Our goal was shared at a Learning Celebration on April 27 and 28th. The video was premiered on April 27th.

Students were the stars of an 11 minute documentary video highlighting

our Class Charters

Our APL related activities were regularly featured in newsletters, Twitter and emails.

#### Planned Actions for 2016-2017

- Implement a Daily SEL practice in all classrooms. Currently the staff have received training in the Mood Meter.
- Establish Class Charters by October 31, 2016
- Establish a School-Wide Charter that has common elements from all 24 Class Charters.
- Continue with professional development focused on Social Emotional Learning.
- •Continue with a Learning Celebration in April 2017.

Welcome Mrs. Peirovi! Mrs. Peirovi is our evening caretaker. She replaces Mr. Olpretean who took a position at


