PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (Bryn Williams aka BW)

- Start Smart was shortened as the staffing for Westwood has been stabilized. Families who
 has concerns about class assignments and new timings should not hesitate to speak with
 BW.
- Pictures were taken but will not be circulated; these will just be shown at the year end at the presentation for the whole school.
- Hopefully teachers will get on to Fresh Grade for the benefit for all families, but some teachers choose not to use Fresh Grade
- Construction at the school will start at 7am, and there are proper signages and areas cordoned off for the safety of the children while at school.
- Some families are concern about the new timings at school. New timings are to incorporate supervised lunch in the classes.
- Monitors will continue have the opportunity to carry out their roles in different aspects around the school.
- Playground upgrade is still in the pipeline; the district is still waiting for the quotes for the project. BW will stay on top of this project to get it done.
- Music instruments were purchased over the summer by Mrs. Rowe. PAC needs to vote on the amount of nearly \$2000; and revert to what can be used from the PAC account.
- Classroom funds- each class gets \$400 for bus/event/activity and \$200 for in classroom supplies. Teachers are advised to use these funds well before the end of the school year in June 2020 so as to ensure that the school utilizes its grants completely and not reflect too much of a surplus at the end of the school year.
- For 2019/2020; the school has 11 divisions with 208 students plus potential International students (about 7) to join the school.

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PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Chair: Raquel & Vice Chair: Darla)

- Welcome New PAC Members
- Correspondence- BCTF Parent Info session. A possibility for Pink Shirt Day to have an Antibully theme at the Parent Info Session for this event.
- Saleema Noon (SN), Body Science Workshop during school hours and the teachers are
 on board with the date. Parents session will be held before the student session. SN have
 January dates available. SN will most likely group the Grades according age-appropriate
 content focus. 21 Jan is for Parents info session and 23 Jan is for student. Need to get BW
 to approve the dates (i.e. check with the teachers that it does not clash with class activities
 etc.)
- Form Grade 5 Committee for 2019/20 needs to be communicated. Their tasks include ordering Hoodies, PAC financial support, planning for end of year event. Grade 5 families should be informed and communicated that the G5 comm is separate from PAC. The teachers are also involved in the planning of the ceremony and trip. The dates for these needs to be decided and locked in as a Cultus Lake gets booked up fast. The end product of the hoodies and t-shirt NEEDS to be double checked that the design & colour matches the original design & colour submitted.
- From PAC Raq/ Jenn/ Claire/Hadar/Melissa will be part of the Grade 5 Comm. \$3700 was spent on the ceremony last year, although the budget was \$2300 The school had a surplus, so the amount spent was acceptable.
- Spirit Wear /PAC / Staff shirts- sample sizes will arrive soon at the school. Also, to consider Western Athletic for other items (water bottle, caps..etc.). To consider a theme for each year to promote families to buy every year.
