Why is SD43 pursuing 'The Greenest School in Canada'?

- 1. It's the right thing to do
 - As educational leaders one of the best ways of making real change is to lead by example and to educate our kids on why this is so important.
 - By teaching our kids, we have the best chance of creating real change.
- 2. SD43 really needs a new Gr. 6-12 school* for Burke Mountain for 2023
 - No one wants to see an even greater number of portables at neighbourhood schools. (*Please Note: A grade 6-12 school is a short-term solution. The school will become a grade 9-12 secondary school when enrolment increases and funding is approved for the addition of a 6-8 middle school).
 - Provincial funding for this school has not yet been received.

Will it slow down the process of having a new school built on Burke Mountain?

- No, the district will continue moving forward as quickly as possible with the intent of having the school open for 2023. To do this, provincial support is needed immediately.
- The level of green initiatives accomplished will be based on the amount raised toward the premium cost which is above regular provincial funding.

How will SD43 pay for the added premium cost of these green upgrades?

• SD43 is actively seeking sponsorship through grants and private tax-deductible donations.

How will the building of a green school benefit the rest of the District?

- A new green school create a new standard in the level of building that the district constructs.
- Expertise gained in the construction of this building can be used in other new buildings and potentially used to retrofit existing buildings.
