

Proposed Catchment Areas Announcement

November 16, 2017

As a part of the annual district-wide catchment boundary review, catchment areas and Programs of Choice needing alterations for the 2018-2019 school year have been identified and it was determined that action is required in a few areas. Currently, there are some catchment areas where a few students attend a different middle school or secondary school than their classmates. These proposed changes below help to align the catchments by level for these students. **These changes are proposed to be applied as students enter a new school.**

Details regarding the proposed catchment area changes outlined below will be shared at the Catchment Area Information Session for Regular Programs.

Proposed Changes for Catchment Areas

1. Porter Street Elementary and Mountain View Elementary:
 - a. 757 – 935 (odd address numbers) Foster Avenue students between Robinson Street and Blue Mountain Street are proposed to change from the Mountain View Elementary catchment to the Porter Street Elementary catchment.
 - b. 651-753 (odd address numbers) Blue Mountain Street students between Foster Avenue and Como Lake Avenue are proposed to change from the Porter Street Elementary catchment to the Mountain View catchment. To note, some of these students are already in the Mountain View catchment.
2. Cape Horn Elementary and Rochester Elementary:
 - a. All Marathon Court students are proposed to change from the Cape Horn Elementary catchment to the Rochester Elementary catchment.
3. Montgomery Middle and Pitt River Middle:
 - a. The boundary between Montgomery Middle and Pitt River Middle is proposed to change from Loughheed Highway to the Coquitlam River. This area is currently designated as a Natural Area and is not zoned for housing and thus, there are no students living in this proposed area change.
4. Centennial Secondary and Port Moody Secondary:
 - a. 757 – 935 (odd address numbers) Foster Avenue students between Robinson Street and Blue Mountain Street are proposed to change from the Port Moody Secondary catchment to the Centennial Secondary catchment.
 - b. 655 – 763 (odd address numbers) Hailey Street students are proposed to change from the Centennial Secondary catchment to the Port Moody Secondary catchment.
 - c. 651-1015 (odd address numbers) and 654-754 (even address numbers) Blue Mountain Street students north of Foster Avenue are proposed to change from the Centennial catchment to the Port Moody Secondary catchment.
