Come on out for some Creative Problem Solving Fun Odyssey of the Mind Style!

For Students in Grades 3-5:

**What's in a Box? A Box of Possibilities!
A Design! Build! Share! Challenge.**

Start out with the story of "Caine's Arcade" and the Global Cardboard Challenge as inspiration. Learn some construction tips for using cardboard as a building material, the magic of duct tape and other useful joining and fastening tricks. Then use what you learned and have fun working with a small group of kids to build something awesome out of cardboard, recycled materials and imagination. Join in the afternoon celebration as everyone shares their creative solutions to the challenges.



For students in Grades 6-8 and 9-12:

"What Box?" A Design Thinking and CPS Challenge.

Students will work in small groups and select a "What Box?" themed challenge that is hands-on technical or one that has more of a performance focus. Experienced Odyssey coaches will mentor the groups during the day and introduce them to some Design Thinking and CPS strategies that they can use to help them design, create and present their challenge solutions..

COST for Students:

\$20 each for students from **Odyssey Member Schools** or whose parent is a member of CPSS.

\$30 each for students from non-Odyssey schools. Both include a recess snack, and pizza and a drink for lunch. Note: (You can buy a \$5 membership when you register and get the \$20 rate)
