# Hello everyone,

In the many conversations we have had with parents, students and staff, we hear that you are looking ahead to next week with a mix of excitement at school re-starting, relief at being able to go back to your familiar friends and places, and wonderings about some of the uncertainty we still feel. Care for the well-being of everyone in our school community is our first goal in all our planning and preparation. Everything we do going forward is a team effort; in school, at home, in our communities, and in our workplaces.

## **Key Information**

- 1. Starting on Thursday September 10th, before any student comes to school, please go over the **Daily Health Check** (attached) for any of the symptoms on that list. If your child has any of those symptoms, complete the online absence form to confirm their absence. Keep your child at home. You will NEED to do this at the beginning of every day.
- 2. September 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Please make sure that your children maintain social distance (2 metres) on September 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> from other children and families we will be meeting outside. The schedule is below.

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3. Late on Friday the 11th or over the weekend you will receive an email from your child's new teacher, welcoming them to the class and letting them know where to meet on Monday the 14th.

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### Where to meet your teacher:

You will meet with your teacher in an outdoor location. I will send this specific information to you next week. When you check in, tell the teacher what you have missed most about Baker Drive. If there are handouts, we will have them for you then. Your teacher will tell you where to meet on Friday.

## **Friday instructions**

On Friday you will see same teacher. You will spend about 45 minutes to an hour with them, learning our new procedures. Students must maintain physical distance of two metres from other students and from staff during this time. This will also be outside.

#### Weekend

You will receive an email from your new classroom teacher welcoming your child to their new class. If you don't receive an email by Saturday evening, please email me directly. We have had a few situations where email from the school has been filtered out as spam – check your spam/junk mailbox too

#### Masks

Students are not required to wear masks at this time, but you are more than welcome to send your child with a mask.
