#### Tuesday, September $2^{nd}$ , 2014 - 8:55 - 9:30

- <u>INCOMING KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS</u> Please meet in the front foyer to sign in and sign up for a welcome meeting time. You do not need to stay until 9:30.
- <u>NEW STUDENTS (Grades 1-5) TO BIRCHLAND who have PRE-REGISTERED</u> Please meet in the library to sign in and receive a tour of the school.
- NEW STUDENTS TO BIRCHLAND WHO HAVE NOT PRE-REGISTERED (Grades K-5) Please come to the office with the following: child's birth certificate, your birth certificate and proof of residency/status in Canada to complete the registration process.

- Grade 1 5 Students in school for regular day (8:55 2:55)
- Kindergarten students/parents attend their welcoming meetings.

- Kindergarten students attend for mornings only (8:55 11:55)
