The All About Me program is designed to provide fun, safe and affordable after school programming to the families at Birchland Elementary School. The programming is provided free of charge, which a nominal \$0.75 snack fee to cover the expenses of after school snacks for the children.

This term we are offering five different sessions that students can register for. Each of the groups will be small in size and focused on specific activities. Student can register for more than one activity (if dates don't conflict) but we ask that you rank then in 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice in case space becomes an issue in any of the sessions.

The Young Performers Workshop sessions being provided are being taught by a professional actor and usually cost between \$40-\$60 to attend. In order to facilitate future offerings like this we give families the option of making a \$25 donation to the All About Me Program when registering for Young Performers Workshop.
