The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on the Internet at http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat survey. Any computer with an Internet connection can be used, and access to the e-survey is simple and secure. All that is required is a logon number that the school will provide to participants. Provincial, District and School Reports for previous years can be viewed at the same site, without a logon number.

The school is available for parents who would like to participate but do not have access to a computer. Just give a call to the office and we will set a time for you.

For parents who do not wish to use school computers, local public library computers may be another option.
