Blended Model of Instruction:

Face-to-face classroom methods (twice a week, 3 hours each, AM/ PM), combined with computer moderated activities (online 3 days)

Courses: Biology 12; Career Life Education (Planning 10); Chemistry 11; English 10,11,12; Mathematics 10,11; Physics 11,12; PE 10; Fitness & Conditioning 11/12; Social Studies 11.

Skill Building - Grades 8, 9 & 10

Courses are non-credit. Students may take these courses to review previously covered course content OR preview a course that they will take in the future. No final lettergrade issued nor will it be recorded on their transcript.

Remedial - Grades 9 & 10

Courses provide a path for students who achieved 40-49% in a course to attain a passing grade. For grade 9& 10 remedial courses, students will be able to update their mark to 50% (C-)
