### Fast Track

Blended Model of Instruction; Face-to-face classroom methods (twice a week, 3 hours each, AM/PM), combined with computer moderated activities (online 3 days)

**Dates:** July 4-August 10  
**Location:** Gleneagle Secondary

**Courses:** Biology 12; Career Life Education (Planning 10); Chemistry 11; English 10,11,12; Mathematics 10,11; Physics 11,12; PE 10; Fitness & Conditioning 11/12; Social Studies 11.

*Completion of course is within a 6 week timeline*

### Advanced (High School) Credit

Students who complete these courses will receive full credit and a final mark on transcript.

**Dates:** July 4-August 10  
**Locations:** Centennial Secondary, Gleneagle Secondary

### Skill Building and Remedial

**Dates:** July 10-27  
**Times:** 8:30-11:30 & 12:00-3:00pm  
**Location:** Centennial Secondary

**Skill Building - Grades 8, 9 & 10**  
 Courses are non-credit. Students may take these courses to review previously covered course content OR preview a course that they will take in the future. No final letter-grade issued nor will it be recorded on their transcript.

**\*\* Courses:** English, English for School Success, Math, Jazz, Band, Concert Band, Science, Fitness, Tech Ed, Coding (Info Tech).



**Remedial - Grades 9 & 10**  
 Courses provide a path for students who achieved 40-49% in a course to attain a passing grade. For grade 9& 10 remedial courses, students will be able to update their mark to 50% (C-)
