AP Exam Information (important information, please read)

- 1) You will receive an email confirmation of your registration the week of March 12th. Please check your junk folder.
- 2) All exams will take place at Centennial school, in Room B114. The only exception is the AP Microeconomics exam, which will take place in Room B205. (Note: If there is a change in location, you will be emailed prior to the exam. Please remember to check your inbox for any last minute changes.)
- 3) You must be present **at least 30 minutes** before the exam to fill out the required paperwork.
- 4) **What to Bring to the Exam Room:**
 - Government-issued or School-issued photo ID. (Please refrain from bringing in an old passport with a baby picture. Use recent photo ID. A go-card is a good form of ID.)
 - Several sharpened No.2 pencils with erasers
 - Two pens with black or dark blue ink only, for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.

- Your six-digit school code. This can be found on the college board's website below:

Enter the search criteria on the website. Ex. School code for Centennial students is 821065.
(Note: These SAT codes are the same as the AP codes.)
- A watch that does not beep or have an alarm (in case you cannot see the clock in the room)
- Up to two approved calculators with necessary capabilities if you are taking the AP Calculus, Chemistry or Biology exams.

5) **What NOT to bring to the exam room:**

- Electronic equipment (phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices - MP3 player, iPod, etc. - cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices).
- Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or coloured pencils
- Protractors
- Scratch paper
- Computers or calculators (except as previously noted).
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm, or smartwatches
- Food or Drink
- Ear plugs
- Clipboards

6) See below for the scheduled AP Exams at Centennial School. (Note that times listed are starting times for exams. You are required to be present **at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the exam.**)

It is your responsibility to be present at the appropriate time for your registered exams. You will NOT be sent a reminder.
