Volunteer Positions

School District No. 43 (Coquitlam)'s International Education Program is seeking volunteers for its Summer School Programs from July 8 - August 9, 2024. International students participate in English as a Second Language classes in the morning and may also participate in afternoon cultural activities. The cultural activities afternoon is an opportunity for students from overseas to experience Canadian culture by participating in group and team activities and tours and by exploring the beautiful outdoors of the Lower Mainland area of BC. Alternately, international students may enroll in credit courses and be working toward graduation requirements instead.

Volunteers are an important component of the International Education Program's Summer School. We have a number of different opportunities for volunteers to work with students in the ESL classes, computer classes, credit courses, and sometimes in the cultural activities component of the program.

Requirements

The successful candidate would ideally:

- be enrolled as a student in Grade 10, 11, or 12 in a secondary school in School District No. 43 (Coquitlam)
- be seeking admission to a university education program
- possess leadership, organizational, and interpersonal skills
- be proficient with the English language
- have experience with a second language

Note: first aid certification, experience working with international students, and knowledge of Mandarin, Spanish or Korean are assets. Students outside of the aforementioned criteria will also be considered.

If you or someone you know is interested, please send us an application by June 14, 2024. The volunteer hours may be used towards graduation, if you are in grade 10-12. A letter will be provided to you at the end.
