# **U. OF GUELPH ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

The Dr. Franco J. Vaccarino President's Scholarships recognize top international students who have made significant contributions to their school and their community and demonstrate the potential to become a leader in society. Scholarships are \$8,250/year, plus one \$9,500 stipend for a full-time summer research assistantship position after first year. Applicants will be automatically considered for Guelph's Academic Leadership International Entrance Scholarships, worth \$20,000. <u>Applications</u> are due January 25, 2022
