Reminder, Grade 12 students can now make their post-secondary institution (PSI) selections in the <a href="StudentTranscripts Service">StudentTranscripts Service</a> (STS). How and when transcript information is sent will depend on the PSI and the options selected in STS. For full details, please visit the <a href="Transcripts and Post-Secondary Selection">Transcripts and Post-Secondary Selection</a> web page. Grade 12 students can make up to 25 free PSI selections in STS. They are also entitled to order one free printed transcript (by mail) after graduation, which can be sent to any address they choose.

All other transcript orders in STS (including <a href="PDF transcripts">PDF transcripts</a>) are \$10 each.

# \*\*\*SLOW DOWN AND USE CAUTION IN THE DRIVEWAY/DROP OFF AREA IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL\*\*\*

Students are reminded to slow down and use the designated crosswalks when crossing through the school driveway area.
