 - d. Click on the Assessment you wish to view to see your result.

*UPDATED INFO - GRAD COMPASS CARD PASSES FOR PUBLIC TRANSIT

Grads can pick up 2 GradPass Compass cards for **free rides** on Translink Buses, SeaBuses, Skytrains or West Coast Express. Each pass is valid for one full day of unlimited travel.

Your Compass GradPass must be used in conjunction with your valid secondary school or government issued photo ID and is **valid from May 15-June 30**.
