### **UBC BEYOND TOMORROW ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS**

A number of award categories are available to support undergraduate Black Canadian students applying to both campuses. Some are one-time and some are renewable up to \$80,000. In addition to the financial assistance, scholars will be supported with a range of programming dedicated to student success. Submit their UBC application and complete the [Beyond Tomorrow Scholars Award application](#) by **December 1st**.

### **UBC CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Graduating High School students with demonstrated financial need and a strong academic record are eligible to apply. Must submit UBC application and the Centennial Scholars Award application by **December 1<sup>st</sup>**.
