Remote Indigenous communities in Canada are struggling with on-going isolation due to pandemic restrictions. In many cases families live in overcrowded homes with no internet and their main source of entertainment, visiting each other, is no longer an option. This is taking a mental and emotional toll. We can all work together to help by providing activity supplies for these families.



Activity supplies for all ages: art & craft kits, puzzles, board games, cards, paint kits and paint supplies, colouring books for children and adults, crayons, markers, word puzzle books, knitting supplies, etc. are being collected and will be boxed up and shipped for distribution to families in a remote Indigenous community. You will receive information about the community that your school is shipping to.

The goal of this campaign is to let children, youth and their families, who are living in remote Indigenous communities know that they are no longer an invisible segment of our society ... that we see them.
