Summer School and Coquitlam Online Courses

As summer rapidly approaches, many students choose to engage in summer learning. This can be done in the form of online courses and summer school classes at schools such as Gleneagle. This year, Continuing Education will require that all registrants me the eligibility requirements for funding. International students pay a charge for summer school. For Gleneagle students, this means that first step in getting ready for summer learning is to ensure that their student records are up to date. Students should see their counsellor or Ms. Page in the office to check their permanent records file. Eligibility for funding requires each of the following three document categories is complete.

1. Parent Citizenship Status:

Parent's Canadian Birth Certificate <u>or</u> Canadian Passport <u>or</u> Canadian Citizenship Card <u>or</u> Landing/Permanent Residence card with passport <u>or</u> work visa (work permit, proof of employment, and passport) <u>or</u> study visa (study permit, Letter of Acceptance from school/transcript, and passport) <u>or</u> refugee claimant documentation.

2. Child's Citizenship Status:

Child's Birth Certificate <u>or</u> Passport <u>or</u> Permanent Residence card <u>or</u> student study visa <u>or</u> refugee claimant documentation.

3. Residency status:

One of the following: Tenancy Agreement <u>or</u> Property Purchase Agreement <u>or</u> Income Tax Statement <u>or</u> Property Tax Statement.

<u>OR</u>

Two of the following: Utility Bill <u>or</u> BC Care Card <u>or</u> BC Driver's License <u>or</u> Letter from landlord attesting to your residency and length of tenancy in Canada.
