CAREER LIFE CONNECTIONS 12 COURSE INFORMATION 2019/2020

Welcome to Career Life Connections 12 also known as CLC. This is a MANDATORY non-enrolling GRADED course required for graduation. Assignments are completed independently, online through Office 365 OneNote. These assignments, along with mentoring sessions with your teacher are required.

The aim of Career Life Connections 12 is to enable students the opportunity to inquire, explore, and develop personal interests, passions, and competencies while making connections to and/or exploring learning opportunities, post-graduation options, and career / life-path possibilities. It is a chance to explore who they are, what they want to do, and who they want to become, as well as fostering connections with the community. We will also be spending time working on skills that will be useful to students in the future, whether professionally or as a part of managing their daily life.

This course is designed around the following curriculum big ideas:

- Career-life development includes ongoing cycles of exploring, planning, reflecting, adapting, and deciding.
- Engaging in networks and reciprocal relationships can guide and broaden career-life awareness and options.
- A sense of purpose and career-life balance support well-being.
- Lifelong learning and active citizenship foster career-life opportunities for people and communities.

In the course students will be required to complete six online assignments as well as create and present an in-person capstone project. ALL assignments must be completed in order to receive credit for the course. The CLC mark will count towards a student's GPA and Honour Roll status.
