






## RE-WRITES — ENGLISH 12 PROVINCIAL OR NUMERACY 10 ASSESSMENT



#### 160 - \$5,000 Scholarships Awarded

The Canadian Scholarships are awarded to eligible students across all provinces and territories in Canada.

#### **Eligibility:**

To be eligible to apply for the Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be graduating high school (or be in the final year of CEGEP) with plans to enter university in the fall of 2020
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree program at an accredited university
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000 or less annual net income per family is required)
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Maintain a minimum grade percentage of 65
- Attend high school (or CEGEP) and reside in Canada
- Be Canadian citizens




