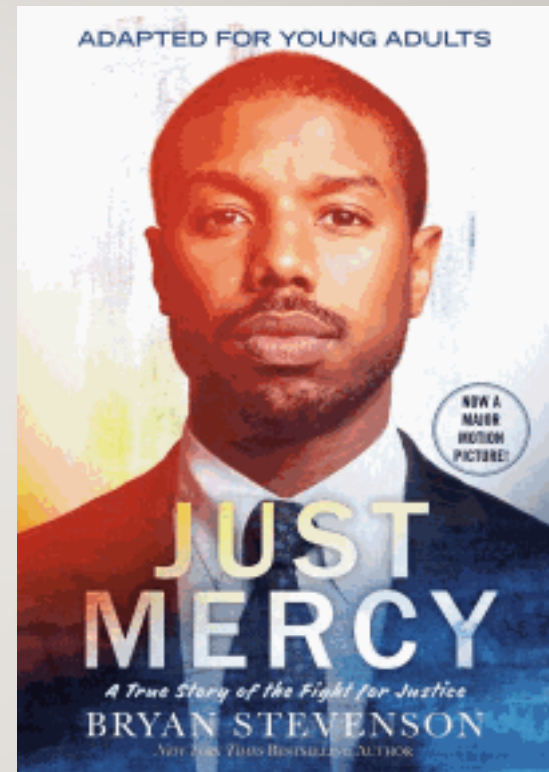
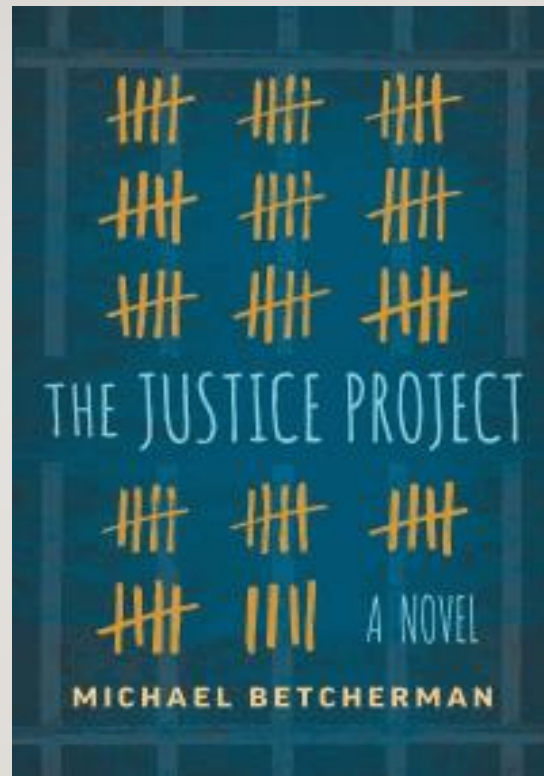

Lester B. Pearson International Scholarship Program

Lester B. Pearson International Scholarship Program at the University of Toronto is intended to recognize international students who demonstrate exceptional academic achievement and creativity and are recognized as leaders within their school. A special emphasis is placed on the impact the student has had on the life of their school and community, and their future potential to contribute positively to the global community. Awarded annually, these scholarships recognize outstanding students from around the world, including international students studying at Canadian high schools. This is U of T's most prestigious and competitive scholarship for international students. Each year approximately 37 students will be named Lester B. Pearson Scholars.

Eligibility:

International student (i.e. a non-Canadian requiring a study permit)

Original and creative thinker committed to school and community

High achiever in academic and creative pursuits

Enthusiastic about learning and intellectual exploration

Has demonstrated strong leadership skills

Currently in their final year of secondary school

Planning to begin university in the upcoming academic year
