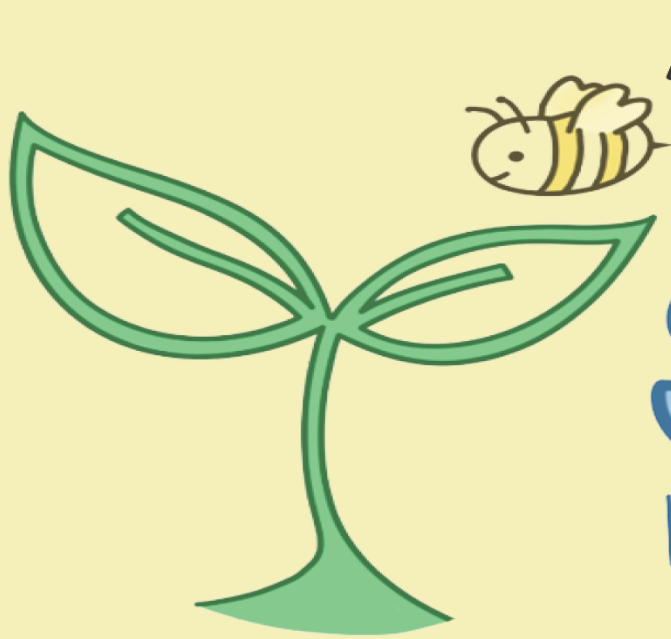
LOST AND FOUND
