

- Grade 12s ONLY in the Grand Hall




WHY IS GOOD DIGITAL COMMUNICATION IMPORTANT?

> How can digital communication help? 1. Increases Flexibility 2. Improves Production 3. Easy to edit 4. Many tools are accessible to be shared




## KWAP Clothing Drive

Please treat them as though they are a real infant






