




# FLEXpectations



### ADULTING 101: PERSONAL FINANCE FOR STUDENTS PREPARING FOR COLLEGE & UNIVERSITY

### A Zoom-based financial literacy workshop for grade 10-12 students from UVIC's Gustavson School of Business

Surveys routinely show Canadians struggle with their finances—over half are within \$200 of not being able to cover their bills and debt payments.

High school and university students particularly face struggles. <u>Rising student debt</u> increasing housing costs, and surging inflation are barriers to success. *Generation Z* not only faces the burdens of climate change, the pandemic, and global uncertainty—but costs alone are a barrier to progress in careers and life.

### So, how can students prepare for the costs of "adulting" and identify opportunities while at university?

The Gustavson School of Business at UVic invites all grade 10/11 students to join afree financial literacy workshop. Dr. Michael King leads this interactive session for students to strengthen and prepare their financial footing to enter university life. This workshop will give you a taste of Gustavson and finance through a fun and engaging session.
