Emily Carr University of Art + Design and Coquitlam School District #43 are pleased to announce the continuation of a partnership that will see ECU offer a first year studio course, taught by Emily Carr at Gleneagle Secondary School in Fall 2023.

This course will be available to current Grade 11 or 12 students or recent graduates from any of the secondary schools in School District #43 and surrounding area. The course will carry degree credit at Emily Carr University and transfer credit to other Fine Art programs. The course is particularly aimed at students considering post-secondary studies in visual art, media art or design.

### FNDT 112 Foundation Drawing Studio

Day & Time:

Tuesdays, 6:00-9:00pm Gleneagle Secondary School

Dates:

1195 Lansdowne Drive, Coquitlam September 12th to December 12th, 2023

This course explores the fundamentals of drawing such as line, shape, tone, texture, volume, proportion, shadow, space, composition, scale, mark-making tools, and media. Exercises and projects work on perceptual and expressive drawing and hand-eye coordination. Inclass projects and homework assignments will encompass various aspects of drawing while visual presentations and class discussion will introduce students to contemporary and historical ideas of art and design.



### ACADEMIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

This is a UNIVERSITY LEVEL COURSE. Students are expected to meet Emily Carr University academic admission requirements:

One grade 11 or 12 course from English Language Arts. Two grade 11 or 12 courses from any of the following categories: Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, or Languages, plus two other grade 11 or 12 courses from any of the above and/or Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies or Arts Education.

SPACE IS LIMITED - Admission will be determined by calculating the averages of the five courses described above and then ranking the candidates.

Upon acceptance to the program, students are responsible for the full amount of tuition.
