



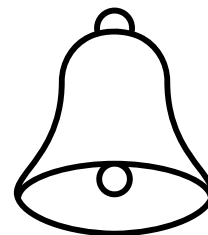

UBC Physics Circle



- The UBC [Physics Circle](#) is a program catering to motivated and advanced high school students (grades 10-12) in physics. Our main goal is to foster curiosity, creativity, and a sense of community. The Circle will consist of **2-hour sessions on Wednesdays (from 5:00-7:00 PM), happening every 2-3 weeks**, and will be held in the Outreach Lab (HEBB 212) on UBC Vancouver Campus.

Each session has two parts:

- Part 1: UBC Physics & Astronomy professors will give lectures on advanced physics topics, including sharing some of their research.
- Part 2: Participating students will be given challenging problem sets to solve; this can prepare students for physics contests such as the [CAP Prize Exam](#) and the [Sir Isaac Newton Exam](#).

- A \$5 registration fee/Term is required to cover the cost of running the sessions and offering pizza dinner for participating students and volunteers. Please bring the Term 1 \$5 fee to the first session in November. **No students will be turned away for the lack of funds.**

Session dates: This Fall Term 1 (2023), sessions will begin on Wednesday November 1st, 2023 and will run until the end of April, 2024. The Term 2 (2024) format will be announced in late December.

We strongly encourage students underrepresented in STEM - girls, Indigenous youth, and those from underprivileged communities - to participate.



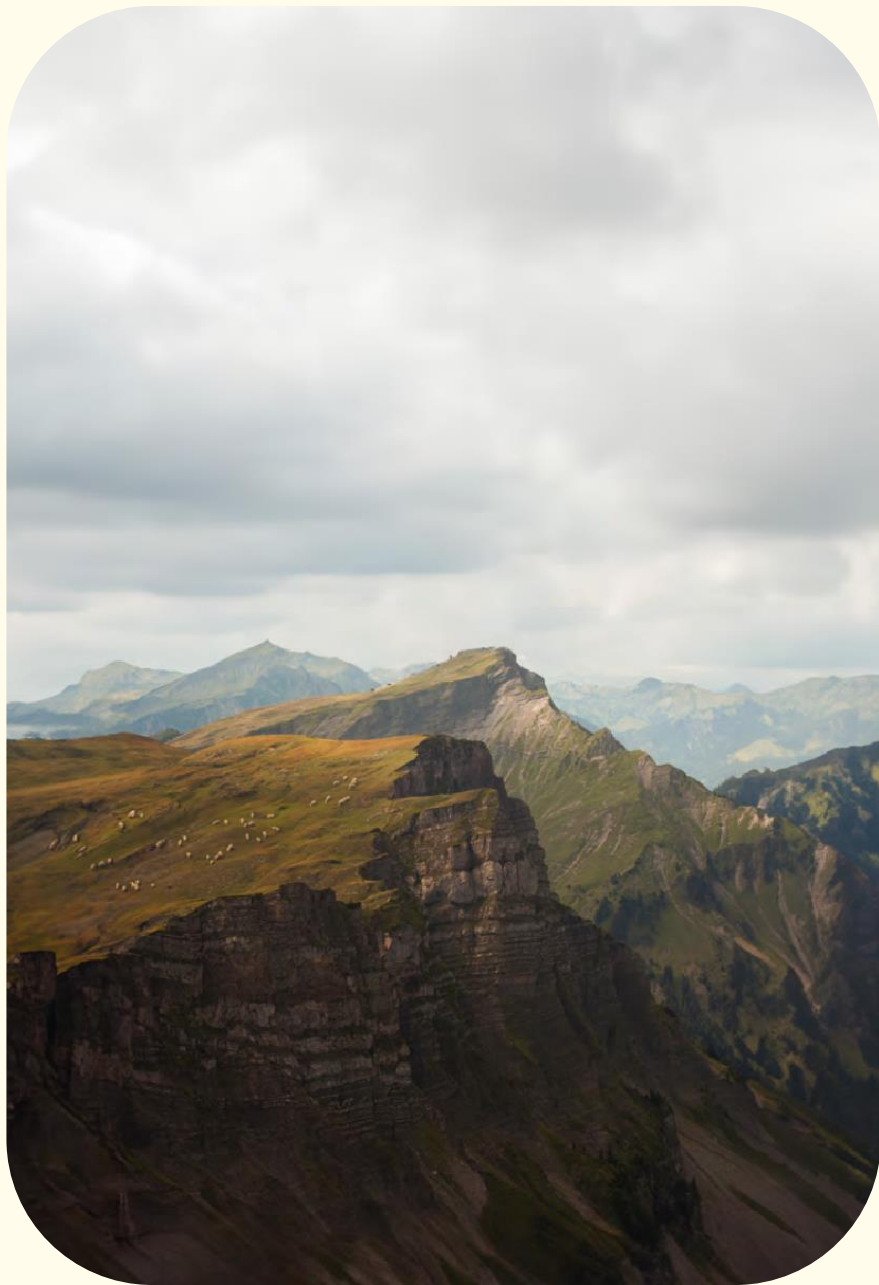

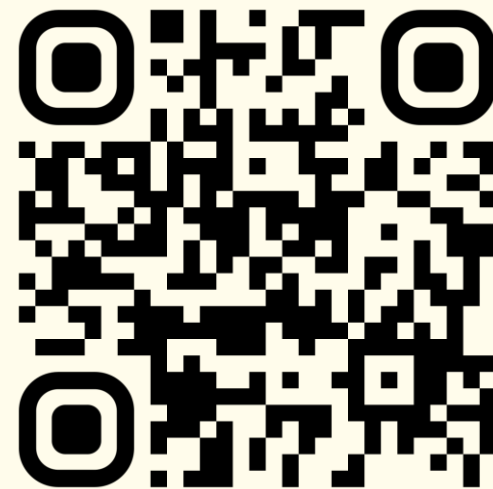
