All grade 9, 10, 11 students: MyEd course requests will be opening back up on Thursday, March 7th for students to verify their course requests for next year.

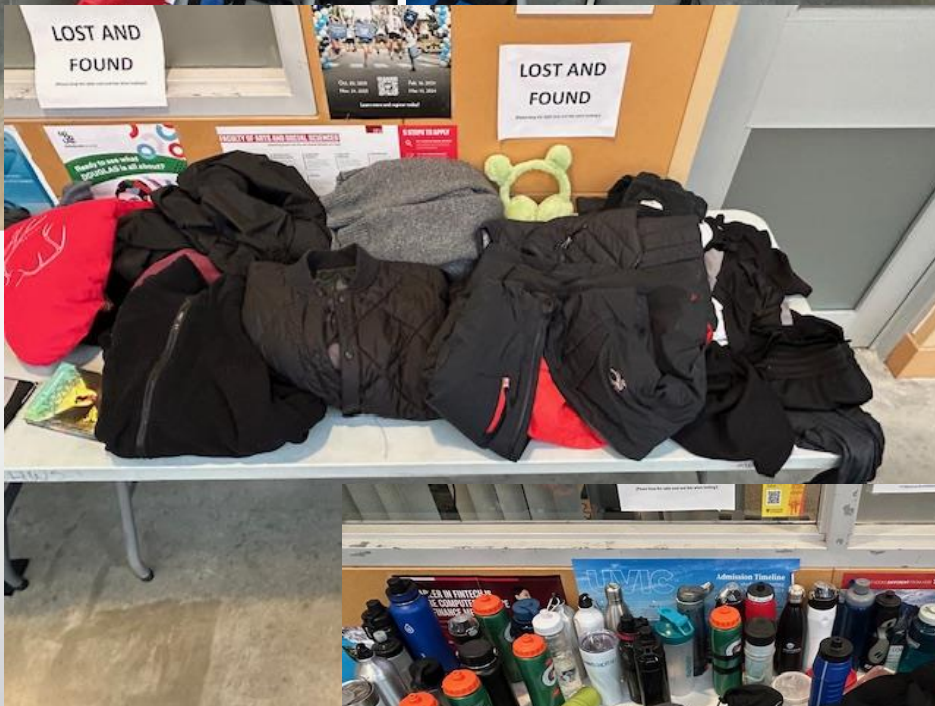



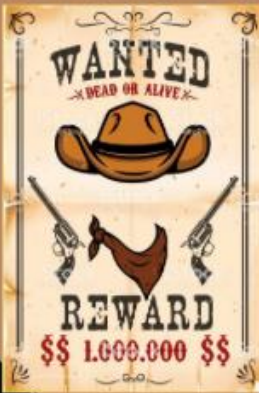
