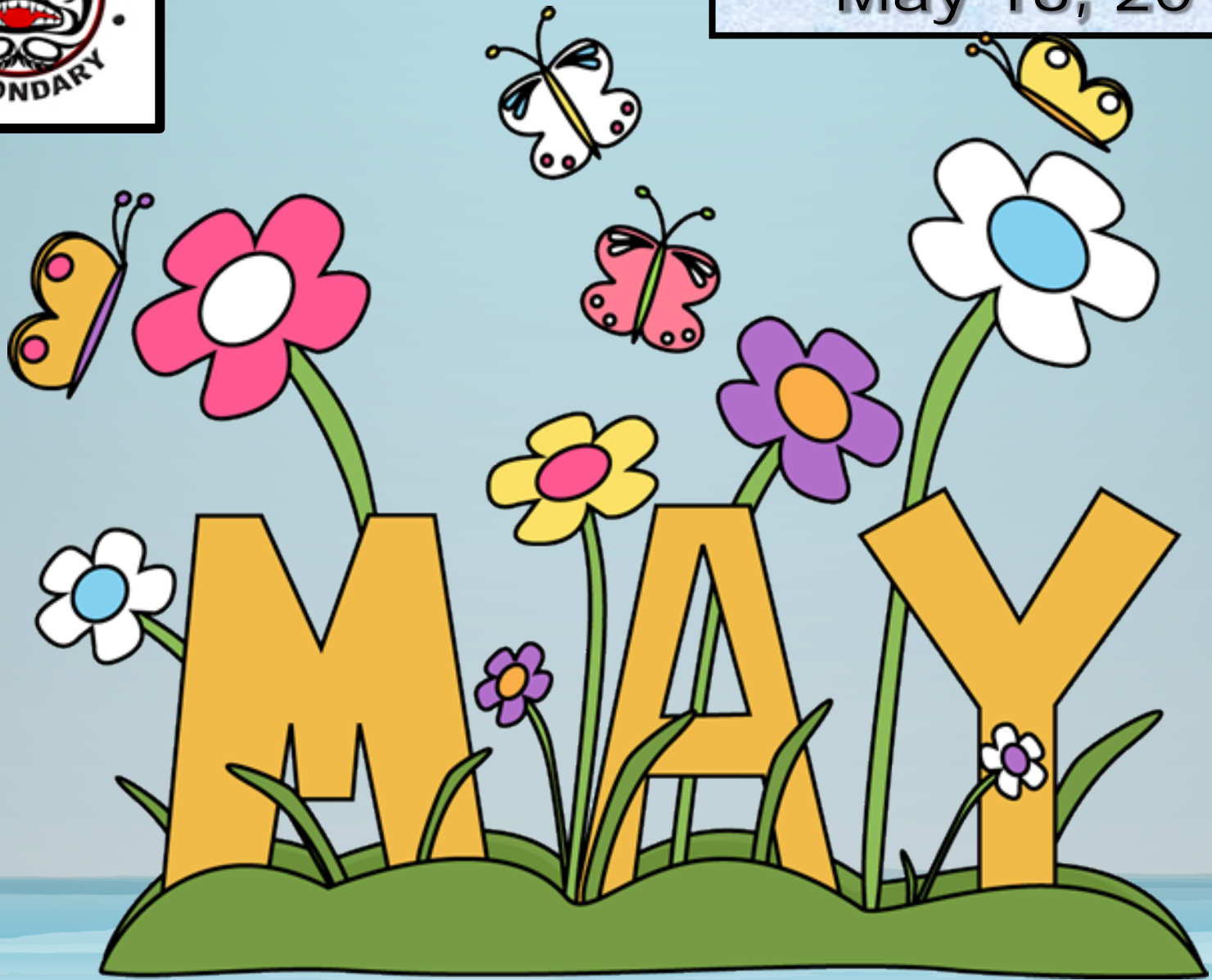

What is “youth culture”, and how does it play into the generational gap between the youth generation and the older generations today?

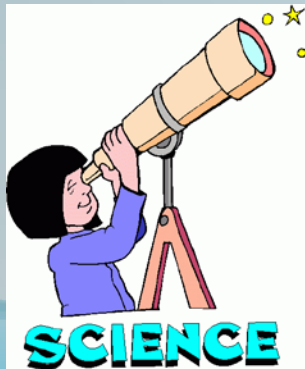
Parents, teachers, and students are welcome to join us in the evening event, where students define “youth culture” through a variety of works: poetry, films, performances, and more!



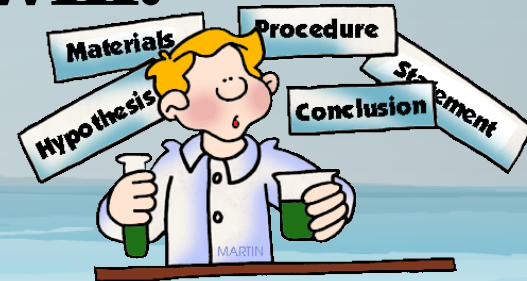
# CONGRATULATIONS to Christopher Halim, Nirvon Shoa, and Angela Yoo

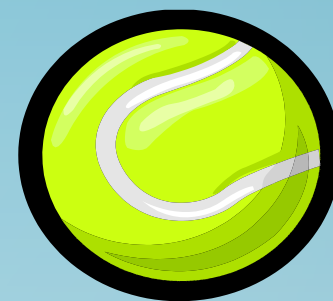

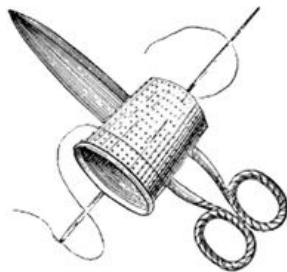
